





Definitions



But yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, into the depth of the pit.



The Fall of The Angels

Revelation 12:7 And there was a great battle in heaven: Michael and his angels fought with the dragon, and the dragon fought, and his angels. And they prevailed not: neither was their place found any more in heaven. And that great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, who seduceth the whole world. And he was cast unto the earth: and his angels were thrown down with him.



There Is No Redemption Or Second Chance For Rebellious Angels



Angelic choices are made by a fully informed, supernatural intellect. Hence, a decision, once made, is irrevocable, eternally unchanging and wholly reflective of their fidelity (or lack of it) to God's rule. The dimension of time also likely applies differently to angels, who probably spend most of their existence in eternity. Can an eternal mind change?

Speculation About Satan



Ejected from Heaven and sentenced to an eternity in Hell (and possibly, eventual total destruction) Satan probably felt that he had nothing left to lose.

Cursing God, Satan vowed to take every single one of God's newly created human beings to Hell with him, if he could. With Satan's angelic powers, as well as his access to the Earth intact, the rest, as we say, is history!

Larceny In The Garden



From the Catechism:

391 Behind the disobedient choice of our first parents lurks a seductive voice, opposed to God, which makes them fall into death out of envy. Scripture and the Church's Tradition see in this being a fallen angel, called "Satan" or the "devil". The Church teaches that Satan was at first a good angel, made by God: "The devil and the other demons were indeed created naturally good by God, but they became evil by their own doing."

Willingly Swindled

Adam traded away everything that he owned, all the physical, temporal gifts he had been given by God.

Genesis 1:26 "... dominion over the fishes of the sea, and the fowls of the air, and the beasts, and the whole earth, and every creeping creature that moveth upon the earth".

This was Satan's price for imparting the "Knowledge of Good and Evil". It was a fool's bargain!



The Law of Sin And Death


You Sin ... You Die



So it was that Satan gained control over the whole world and certain dominion over man. The entire process was, in a technical sense, legal but it certainly wasn't right. God wasn't pleased, either. Here, we learn of Satan's destiny:

Genesis 3:15

I will put enmities between thee and the woman, and thy seed and her seed: she (he) shall crush thy head, and thou shalt lie in wait for her (his) heel. 2ndCorinthians 11:3 But I fear lest, as the serpent seduced Eve by his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted and fall from the simplicity that is in Christ.



The words "subtilty" and "seduced" hint at sins of the mind and the flesh, but the specific details of Adam's sin have never been revealed. We'll probably have to wait until Judgment Day to hear the rest of the story.



For a number of reasons, sending a Redeemer would not be easy, even for God. In fact, thousands of years would elapse before the exact time, place and circumstances for Messiah would arrive.



Galatians 4:4-5

But when the fullness of the time was come, God sent his Son, made of a woman, made under the law: That he might redeem them who were under the law: that we might receive the adoption of sons.

Complicating matters still further, only <u>one</u> person in the entire <u>universe</u> was qualified for the job.

Sin ... Public Enemy Number 1


Anyone who is guilty of a serious, intentional, unconfessed, unrepented and unforgiven offense against God or man is likely to be "living in sin"



Anyone who freely chooses a course of action that they know is **gravely sinful**, commits a **mortal sin**, which is serious enough to result in spiritual "death"; effectively "cutting off" that person from God's sanctifying grace.

Living In Sin

From Adam's "Fall" to Jesus' birth, all* of mankind "lived in sin"



*except for the Blessed Virgin, Mary

Sometimes, bad decisions and poor life choices can make it very difficult to receive absolution for our sins

Here, Jesus empowers His Apostles (the first Bishops) to *carefully evaluate* both the <u>sin</u> and the <u>sinner</u>.

John 20:21 –23 **He** (Jesus) said therefore to them again: Peace be to you. As the Father hath sent me, I also send you. When he had said this, he breathed on them; and he said to them: Receive ye the Holy Ghost.

Whose sins you shall forgive, they are forgiven them: and whose sins you shall retain, they are retained.



Analyzing Sinful Lifestyles



Couple "A"

Lives together, <u>permanently</u>, under one "roof" as "man and wife" (sexually active — **not** as brother and sister) without benefit of the Sacrament of Marriage. Under the laws of the Church, <u>absolution</u> for sins <u>may not</u> (typically) be granted.


Couple "B"



Maintains <u>their own separate residences</u>, but <u>occasionally</u> lives together, under one "roof" as "man and wife" (sexually active — **not** as brother and sister) without benefit of the Sacrament of Marriage. Under the laws of the Church, <u>absolution</u> for sins <u>may</u> (typically) be granted.

Why Is Absolution Available In One Case, But Not The Other?

St. Peter tells us in Acts 3:19 ... Be penitent, therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out.



If Our Sins Are To Be Forgiven

Two Conditions Must Be Met

- **✓** We must be sorry (contrition)
- ✓ We <u>must</u> have a firm <u>intention</u>

 and a <u>real possibility</u> of

 <u>amendment</u>

 (repentance/conversion)

A Closer Look At "Couple A"

Choosing to live together without benefit of marriage in order to engage in an active sexual relationship, "Couple A" is "locked-in" to a sinful lifestyle that offers practically no chance for repentance or conversion, making absolution virtually impossible.



Even with contrition and a firm intention to change, considering the couple's shared dwelling and living habits, shared social activities and finances, as well as the obvious sexual issues; it is unlikely that this couple could avoid committing the same sins, all over again, perhaps only minutes or hours after going to Confession.

One partner *moving out* could help resolve the sin issue, or certainly, they could *get married*. Short of this, "Couple A" will likely remain in serious sin ... a very dangerous situation for their eternal souls.

While It's Always Important To Avoid Sin, It Is Absolutely Critical To Avoid Sinful Life Choices Of A Permanent Nature

A Closer Look At "Couple B"

Choosing to engage in a sexual relationship without benefit of marriage, while occasionally "shacking-up" is definitely sinful behavior. But, unlike "Couple A", this couple has not made their arrangement permanent. The temporary nature of their situation makes a big difference, when it comes to the possibility of absolution.



Living apart, and being able to retire to their own separate dwellings, to deal with their own personal faults, free from the pressures of permanent cohabitation, affords this couple a real chance at repentance and conversion. Assuming true contrition and a firm purpose of amendment, there's virtually no reason these people cannot receive absolution, after making a good confession.

This in no way minimizes their bad behavior, or the substantial personal and spiritual risks they run, by persisting in it.

Absolution Is Available If Amendment Is Reasonably Possible

What About Same-Sex Couples?

The same rules apply to same-sex couples too, with one very important exception: No matter what civil law may decree, the Sacrament of Marriage applies only to the very special union between a man and a woman.

Divinely constituted as such, Marriage is a state in life that is holy and Blessed by God. Any type of sexual "intercourse" outside of Marriage is sinful. Since same sex Sacramental Marriage is never possible, same-sex "intercourse" is always sinful.

Cohabiting same-sex couples face the same types of "absolution problems" that unmarried male/female cohabiting couples do.

A "Last-Chance" For Lost Souls

Old age, illness, or infirmity often make it impractical to persist in a sinful lifestyle.

The end of a "relationship" or the imminent death of a "life partner" may provide a "window of opportunity" for repentance and conversion.

Absolution is available in these cases, as God is always willing to forgive. Don't forget, many saints were once "hypocrites" too!



Just Because It's Legal Doesn't Mean It's Right!

In Nazi Germany during the 1930's and 1940's it was "legal" to murder anyone considered "undesirable" or of the "wrong" ethnic background, religion, or political party.






Today, in much of the United States of America,

The **Bottom Line** On Sin

Sin causes us to become separated from God, in spite of His great love for us.



It's critically *important* for everyone (young and old) to receive good, comprehensive, and *continuous* faith education. When a person comes to truly *know* and *love* God, it becomes *easier* to *accept* and put into *practice*, *all* the *teachings* of His *Church*.

Just like "Couple A" ... Adam and Eye, (and all their offspring) separated from God by sin, and under the certain domination of Satan, were "locked in" to a sinful lifestyle, precluding the "routine" absolution of their sins by God, until Satan's "hold" over them could be broken.


When a Catholic, in the spirit of contrition and repentance, makes a good confession of all known sins to a Priest God, through His Church, His Sacrament and His Priest, freely distributes the fruits of Christ's life, death and resurrection, absolving the individual of sin and restoring spiritual life and grace to the soul.



To Make A <u>Good</u> Confession We <u>Must</u>:

- 1. Be **CONTRITE** Sorrow for sins must **truly exist**.
 - a) sorrow for offending God (best)
 - b) sorrow because we want to avoid hell (ok)
 - c) a combination of the two (typical)
- 2. Be <u>REPENTAINT</u> A <u>firm</u> purpose of amendment <u>must</u> <u>exist</u>. We must <u>fully intend to resist temptation</u>, to sin no more, and to avoid the people, places, and things, that <u>lead</u> us into sin.
- 3. Be <u>CONSCIENTIOUS</u> All <u>known</u> mortal sins <u>must</u> be confessed. Because <u>just one</u> mortal sin cuts us off from God's sanctifying grace, <u>deliberately</u> <u>holding back even one</u> makes our confession <u>void</u> and our absolution <u>incomplete</u> and <u>ineffective</u>.

The Wages Of Sin Is Death



But the grace of God is life everlasting in Christ Jesus, our Lord. Romans 6:23





Grace - The Unmerited Favor Of God Comes In Two Varieties:

Actual Grace: Enlightens, guides and empowers us to conform our human will to God's divine will.

Sanctifying Grace: Literally, the living Presence of the Holy Spirit dwelling within a human soul; transforms us, making us holy and acceptable to God.

But ... Until Jesus Redeemed Us By His Death On The Cross, All Of Mankind* Lacked The Sanctifying Grace Necessary To Enter Heaven



Mankind continues to be born in a "spiritually dead" condition today, as were Abraham, Moses, and all the people, Prophets, and Apostles of old (*except the Blessed Virgin, Mary).

Sanctifying Grace is (normally) obtained through Baptism into the Church. It is maintained and increased by fervently practicing our faith and by attending Mass and receiving the Sacraments; especially Reconciliation and Holy Communion.

Even if God had simply chosen to

forgive Adam's sins, the devil enjoyed

so much power and authority over the

Earth that Satan would have

quickly-found a way to lead Adam

(and mankind) right back into sin.



In His Infinite Wisdom, God Knew That Satan Would First, Have To Be Cast Out.



Jesus Knows


The Deposit Of Faith

The sum total of all Divine Revelation and Truth, as defined by the Holy Catholic Church, gained via three legitimate sources:

- Sacred and Apostolic Tradition truths handed down by the Apostles, and/or revealed through the workings of the Holy Spirit in the everyday life of the Church.

- *Magisterium the God given teaching authority and divinely ordained teaching "office" of the Catholic Church.


There's Something About Mary


599 Jesus' violent death was not the result of chance in an unfortunate coincidence of circumstances, but is part of the *mystery* of God's plan, as St. Peter explains to the Jews of Jerusalem in his first sermon on Pentecost: "This Jesus [was] delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God."393 This Biblical language does not mean that those who handed him over were merely passive players in a scenario written in advance by God.³⁹⁴

From The Catechism: "For the sake of accomplishing his plan of salvation, God permitted the acts that flowed from their blindness."


600 To God, all moments of time are present in their immediacy. When therefore he establishes his eternal plan of "predestination", he includes in it each person's free response to his grace: "In this city, in fact, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the peoples of Israel, gathered together against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed, to do whatever your hand and your plan had predestined to take place."395

Attempting To Resolve God's Greatest Mystery

616 ... No man, not even the holiest, was ever able to take on himself the sins of all men and offer himself as a sacrifice for all. The existence in Christ of the divine person of the Son, who at once surpasses and embraces all human persons, and constitutes himself as the Head of all mankind, makes possible his redemptive sacrifice for all.



St. Augustine of Hippo (354-430)



"Christ demonstrated justice by His death,
He promised power by His resurrection.
What could be more just than to go as far as
the death of the cross, for the sake of
justice? What greater act of power than to
rise from the dead, and ascend to heaven
with the very flesh in which He was slain?"

"First, justice conquered the devil, then power; justice, because Christ had no sin and was most unjustly put to death by the devil; power, because He lived again after death, never to die thereafter."

St. Anselm of Canterbury (1033-1109)

One of the great philosophers and theologians of the middle ages. Archbishop and Scholar. Canonized in 1492 by Pope Alexander IV. **Declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Clement XI in 1720.**



Saint Anselm is the most important Christian theologian in the West between Saint Augustine and Saint Thomas Aquinas.

One of his two great accomplishments is: "Cur Deus Homo" (Why God Became Man)

In which he undertakes to show that Divine Love *responding* to human rebelliousness *requires* that God should *become* a man.



On God's Justice And The Law

Justice to man is regulated by God's law, so that, according to the requirements of law, the measure of award (satisfaction) is determined by God.

Man naturally owes honor, obedience and allegiance to God in all things, so with what could man pay for his sin against God?

Man alone, possesses nothing that can satisfy his debt to God for sin. - St. Anselm





On Sin And Death

For, as death came upon the human race by the disobedience of man, it was fitting that by man's obedience, life should be restored.

And, as sin, the cause of our condemnation, had its origin from a woman, so ought the author of our righteousness and salvation to be born of a woman.

- St. Anselm





On Vanquishing Satan

And so also was it proper that the devil, who, being man's tempter, had conquered him in eating of the tree, should be vanquished by man in the suffering of the tree which man bore.

- St. Anselm





Why Only God Should Redeem Us

... if any other being should rescue man from eternal death, man would rightly be adjudged as the servant of that being.

Now if this be so, he would in no wise be restored to that dignity which would have been his had he never sinned.

For he, who was to be through eternity, only the servant of God, and an equal with the holy angels, would now be the servant of a being who was not God, and whom the angels did not serve. - St. Anselm



Why Only God Could Redeem Us

Nothing can be more severe or difficult for man to do for God's honor, than to suffer death voluntarily when not bound by obligation.

Man cannot give himself to God in any way more truly than by surrendering himself to death for God's honor.

As no sin could be found in Christ, he certainly was not liable to die.

Can anyone fail to see how the sacrifice of the fully divine and fully human Jesus would vastly exceed and transcend any purely human effort? - St. Anselm





Why Was Suffering Necessary?

If man sinned with ease, is it not fitting for him to atone with difficulty?

And if he was overcome by the devil in the easiest manner possible, so as to dishonor God by sinning against him, is it not right that man, in making satisfaction for his sin, should honor God by conquering the devil with the greatest possible difficulty?

Is it not proper that, since man has departed from God as far as possible in his sin, he should make to God the greatest possible satisfaction? – St. Anselm





The Logical Conclusion

God demanded that man should conquer the devil, so that he who had offended by sin should atone by holiness.

As God owed nothing to the devil but punishment, so man must only make amends by conquering the devil as man had already been conquered by him.

Whatever was demanded of man, he owed to God and not to the devil. - St. Anselm






Redemption Reflections

St. Thomas Aquinas (1225-1274)



"The passion of **Christ was of such** value that it sufficed to expiate (atone) for all the sins of the whole world, even of a hundred thousand worlds."

"Propitiation"

Jesus is our "propitiation" because He freely, heroically, and lovingly became the sacrificial victim for our sins.

His sinless, perfect, infinitely valuable sacrifice, as one of us, and on our behalf, appeased (turned away) God's righteous anger, and restored God's eternal favor, obtaining good will, forgiveness, and peace* for all men.






Destroying Satan's Power

Satan, "The Prince Of This World" (John 12:31) bore the ultimate responsibility for unlawfully putting Jesus to death.

Willingly assisted by Rome, Pilate, Herod, the Chief Priests, Pharisees, Judas and others, Satan's fate was sealed the moment Christ died.

By deliberately taking the life of "He who had no sin" Satan broke God's Law of Sin and Death, forfeiting all that he had gained from Adam's fall.





Christ Shed His Blood So Sins Could Be Forgiven

Leviticus 17:11 Because the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you, that you may make atonement with it upon the altar for your souls, and the blood may be for an expiation of the soul.

Matthew 26:28 For this is my blood of the new testament, which shall be shed for many unto remission of sins.

1Peter 1:18-19 Knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things ... but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb unspotted and undefiled, foreknown indeed before the foundation of the world...

The Church And Its' Members Are The Visible Signs Of The Kingdom Of God




From the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

766 The Church is born primarily of Christ's total self-giving for our salvation, anticipated in the institution of the Eucharist and fulfilled on the cross. "The origin and growth of the Church are symbolized by the blood and water which flowed from the open side of the crucified Jesus." "For it was from the side of Christ as he slept the sleep of death upon the cross that there came forth the 'wondrous sacrament' of the whole Church." As Eve was formed from the sleeping Adam's side, so the Church was born from the pierced heart of Christ hanging dead on the cross.

How Could God's Own Death, At Our Hands, Pay A Debt We Owe To Him? -part 1 of 10

- There is something about sin that is totally incompatible with God's Holy nature, and which separates the sinner from God.
- God knew that man would fail and sin, even before He created the world. Knowing this, He still chose to create mankind.
- God loves us enough to allow us the freedom to choose. This is called *free will*. The combination of free will, a physical body, and an eternal soul, makes man unique in all God's creation.
- •Man freely and intentionally sinned, causing an immediate loss of God's sanctifying grace, which resulted in (among other things) physical death and spiritual corruption.



How Could God's Own Death, At Our Hands, Pay A Debt We Owe To Him? - part 2 of 10

- The way in which man chose to sin placed him under the domination of Satan, severely complicating matters, and making man a slave to evil, both in his earthly existence, and later, after physical death, for an eternity, in hell.
- *According to God's justice (and according to the *mystery* of His eternal plan) <u>only</u> a man born <u>without</u> <u>sin</u> could successfully rescue mankind from his decrepit state.
- •Ever since Adam sinned, all of his descendants have inherited (been born in a state of) "original sin". So, to this day, all men are born spiritually "dead" and lacking God's grace*.

*except for the Blessed Virgin, Mary and her divine son, Jesus.



How Could God's Own Death, At Our Hands, Pay A Debt We Owe To Him? -part 3 of 10

- *Without divine intervention, all of mankind would truly be eternally "lost" to sin, death, Satan, and hell.
- Because God loves us and created us to spend eternity with Him in Heaven, He created a woman (The Blessed Virgin, Mary) whom He specially "graced" and preserved from the "stain" of original sin, so she could, in turn, become the mother of the one man who could never be "defiled" by sin of any kind.
- Because God loves us, (and according to His mysterious, eternal plan) He chose to send His own divine son, who we know as Jesus Christ, to be born a man, and to be our Redeemer.



How Could God's Own Death, At Our Hands, Pay A Debt We Owe To Him? -part 4 of 10

- *Jesus volunteered to be our Redeemer because He is obedient to His Father's will and because He loves us.
- Through the power of the Holy Spirit and with the cooperation of the Virgin Mary, Jesus took on flesh, complete with a human soul, and lived a fully human existence in all things, except sin.
- Because Jesus is truly God, sin is not compatible with His divine nature. Because He is truly man, Jesus was tempted and tested by the same evil that affects all men. Jesus successfully resisted all temptation and lived a perfect, sin-free existence.
- In His perfect, impeccable humanity, Jesus constituted Himself as the new "head" of all mankind ... the New Adam.

How Could God's Own Death, At Our Hands, Pay A Debt We Owe To Him? -part 5 of 10

- Because Jesus came to vanquish evil, the Devil and his minions did everything they could to destroy Him, beginning with the Slaughter Of The Innocents, at the hands of King Herod, shortly after Jesus was born. (See Matthew 2: 1-18)
 - In truth, no one could take the life of the fully human, fully divine and totally sinless Jesus, unless He permitted it. Since death is the <u>result</u> of <u>sin</u>, one <u>without sin</u> is <u>not</u> liable to <u>die</u>.
- Jesus willingly came into the world to be our sacrifice for sin.
 Only "in the fullness of time" ... and exactly as predestined by God the Father, would Jesus' eternal destiny come to pass.



How Could God's Own Death, At Our Hands, Pay A Debt We Owe To Him? - part 6 of 10

- That "eternal destiny" is Christ's perfect human existence, His Passion and death on the Cross, and His glorious Resurrection.
 - Through His life, Jesus fulfilled every Messianic Biblical prophecy and revealed many mysteries of God to mankind.
 - Jesus demonstrated, for all people and for all generations, exactly how a man could live a life that is totally obedient to the divine will of our Father in Heaven.
- Jesus inaugurated the Kingdom of God on the earth, and demonstrated the supernatural love that God has for mankind ... and the love that all men should have for one another.



How Could God's Own Death, At Our Hands, Pay A Debt We Owe To Him? - part 7 of 10

- Through His Passion and death, Jesus saved mankind.
 - When Satan and his evil minions willfully and unjustly put Jesus to death, (no one has the right to kill a sinless man, let alone the only begotten Son of God) God's justice demanded that Satan forfeit all the authority he had over the world and over mankind. Subsequently, all power and authority was awarded to Jesus.
 - ► By choosing, for the benefit of mankind and for the glory of God, to become the new "head" of all mankind, to suffer, and to heroically lay down His life, Jesus made forgiveness for sins available to all, and secured God's eternal favor for all of mankind.
 - Jesus established His Church ... the Holy Catholic Church, as the "ordinary" means for all men to obtain the "fruits" of His singular, holy and eternal sacrifice, and hopefully, to gain eternal life.



How Could God's Own Death, At Our Hands, Pay A Debt We Owe To Him? -part 8 of 10

- We know all this is true, because Jesus is a real, well documented, historical person, and because God doesn't lie.
- Jesus fulfilled every Messianic Bible prophecy, to the letter. No one else has done so, or ever will.
- Jesus demonstrated the power of God by His perfect, sinless, earthly existence, by His (truly) charismatic personality, and by His miracles. No one else has done so, or ever will.
- Jesus demonstrated His divinity and His mastery over death by His glorious Resurrection. No one else ever rose from the dead by His own power. No one else ever will.



How Could God's Own Death, At Our Hands, Pay A Debt We Owe To Him? -part 9 of 10

- The only sure way we can receive forgiveness for sins, strive to attain holiness, and hope to gain eternal life, is through grace, faith in Jesus, and active participation in His Church.*
- One should not expect to have a valid "relationship" with God, unless one is also truly united with His Church.*
- •The miraculous growth and continued existence of Christ's Church, in spite of all the evils that remain in the world, and in spite of the terrible sins of all those who flock to the Church for healing and forgiveness, testify to the awesome power, infinite love, and tender mercies of God.

^{*}Fortunately, God is not bound by His own laws, and may make exceptions.


